If you wish to watch the Tyler Rose Marathon or you wish to follow the progress of a friend or family member, the following points are where you can best do so.

The Azalea Trail area

Although most of the streets between Front St and 8th St off of Robertson, Chilton, or College will be blocked, you have several choices:

You can go into this area before 8 a.m. and choose a spot to watch and cheer. After 8 a.m. you will have to park outside of this area around Broadway and walk in.

Because our half marathon and marathon course go back and forth. You can see your friends or family at least 4 times in this area.

First they will come down College from Front Street.

They will return back up on Chilton and reverse direction again to go down Robertson.

After running in the Sunnybrook area, runners will return one last time up College

Highway 64 and 31 for marathon runners

There will be the opportunity to travel ahead of your runner and then pull over to cheer them on.
